Standard Itinerary

Bokta Peak Climbing Itinerary:

Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival at Kathmandu International Airport, welcome Program by Himalayan Nepal Trek staff transfer to Hotel in Kathmandu on BB Plan.

Day 02: Kathmandu

Sightseeing in Kathmandu valley Patan, Pashupatinath, Boudhanath, Swayambhunath. Overnight at hotel.

Day 03: Bhadrapur

Flight from Kathmandu to Bhadrapur 94m. Overnight at Hotel on BB Plan.

Day 04: Ranipul

Drive by jeep to Helok Khola or Ranipul 1792m 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 05: Sherpa Gaun

Trek from Ranipul to Sherpa Gaun 1,740m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 06: Torongten

Trek from Sherpa Gaun to Torongten via Lashetham 3,646m 9/10 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 07: Tseram

Trek from Torongten to Tseram 3,868m 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 08: Tseram

Rest acclimatization day hike to above 4000m back to Tseram. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 09: Ramche

Trek from Tseram to Ramche 4,610 m 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 10: Yalung Glacier

Trek from Ramche to Yalung Glacier 4886m, 4/5 hours. Overnight at Tent.

Day 11: Bokta Base Camp

Trek from Yalung glacier to Bokta peak base camp 5123m 4/5 hours stay at Tent.

Day 12: High Camp

Climbing to Bokta peak high camp. Overnight at tent.

Day 13: Bokta Base Camp

Early in the morning, our climbing guide will take you to the summit of Bokta Peak 6143m and return to the Bokta Peak base camp to stay at Tent.

Day 14: Ramche

Trek from Base Camp to Ramche for 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 15: Torongten

Trek from Ramche to Torongten 2,980m 6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 16: Ranipul

Trek via Lashetham 3,646m and Helok Khola or Ranipul 1792m 8/9 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 17: Ilam Tea Garden

Drive by public jeep to Ilam Tea Garden 370m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 18: Kathmandu

Drive to Bhadrapur airport fly back to Kathmandu transfer to the hotel. Evening farewell dinner in a Typical Nepali Culture restaurant. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan

Day 19: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination.

Includes and Excludes

Includes

- 4 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- permit preparation and sightseeing in Kathmandu, Pashupatinath, Patan, Swayambhunath, Boudhanath, etc. stay overnight at a star label hotel on BB plan.
- 3 Times food per day during the trek. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner including tea or coffee.
- 3 Night 3* star label hotel in Kathmandu on BB plan (on twin sharing basis).
- Domestic flight from Kathmandu to Bhadrapur airport guest and guide (optional: private vehicle or public bus as per participant's preference).
- Drive from Bhadrapur to Helok Khola Ranipul /Bhadrapur by public jeep (optional: private vehicle Helok Khola Ranipul as per participant's preference).
- Staffs transportation Kathmandu / Helok Khola Ranipul/Kathmandu.
- Twin-sharing accommodation during the trek (Tea house, Lodge Hotel).
- Experienced English-speaking trekking and climbing guide (Trained and licensed holder by the government of Nepal).
- Assistance climbing Sherpa 5:1 during the climbing period.
- North Face tent for guests, dining tent, kitchen tent, toilet tent, and mattress.
- Climbing equipment's ice screw, rope, ice axe, screw gate, karabiners (2 locks, 2 unlock), and snow bar.
- Necessary Porter: Porter carries 25kg.
- All Government and local Taxes.
- Peak climbing permit from Nepal Mountaineering Association (NTB).
- Conservation Area entry permits (KCAP).
- Kanchanjunga restricted area permits.
- Trekking Information Management System (TIMS card).
- First aid and equipment for a porter for the extreme adventure route.
- Guide and porter salary as per the company policy and government rules.
- Duffel bag during the trek.
- Company t-shirt, Route map.
- Staff's medical insurance during the trek.

Excludes

- Participants trek equipment and any personal expenses such as alcoholic beverages, phone, battery charging, hot shower, hot/mineral water, and laundry.
 - Emergency rescue and travel Insurance (most required factor in high altitude trek)
 - Trip cancellation cost, loss, damage, and personal effects.
 - Entrance fees for temples, monasteries, and museums during sightseeing and trekking.
 - Tips and gratuities for the staff.
