Mount Churen Himal Expedition Itinerary:

Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival in Kathmandu 1310m, welcome by Himalayan Nepal Trek and transfer to hotel in Kathmandu on BB plan.

Day 02: Preparation

Preparation, Briefings at Departments of Tourism. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 03: Pokhara

Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara 950m/3,116ft 6 hours. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 04: Darbang

Drive from Pokhara to Darbang 1110m/3,641ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 05: Takum

Trek from Darbang to Takum via Dharapani village 1670m/5,479ft. 5 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 06: Lumsang Village

Trek from Takum to Lumsang village 2120m/6,955ft 6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 07: Gurja Village

Trek from Lumsang to Gurja Village 2620m/8,595ft 7 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 08 Darsinge Kharka

Trek Gurja village to Darsinge Kharka 3600m/11,811ft 6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 09: Burjunga Khark

Trek from Darsinge Kharka to Burjunga Khark 3415m/11,204ft. 5 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 10: Base Camp

Trek from Burjunga Kharka to Churen Himal Base Camp 4600m/15,091ft. 3 hours. Overnight at a tented camp.

Day 11-28:

Climbing Period Churen Himal (7371m/24,183ft) Base Camp Summit Base Camp.

Day 29: Burjunga Kharka

Clean up Base Camp and trek from Churen Base Camp to Burjunga Kharka 3415m/11,204ft 5 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 30: Gurja Village

Trek from Burjunga Khark to Gurja Village 2620m/8,595ft 6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 31: Lulang village

Trek from Gurja village to Lulang village 2200m/7,218ft. 5 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 32: Dharapani

Trek from Lulang via Dharapani to Darbang 1670m/5,479ft 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 33: Pokhara

Drive from Darbang to Pokhara via Beni. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 34: Kathmandu

Drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu 1350m/4,429ft 6 hours. Transportation is provided by tourist minibus. Overnight at the hotel on the BB plan.

Day 35: Kathmandu

Leisure day and shopping. Evening farewell dinner in a typical Nepali cultural restaurant. Overnight at hotel on BB plan.

Day 36: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination our representative will assist you to the airport for your further destination ahead.

Includes

- Mt. Churen Climbing certificate issued by the Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Civil Aviation (Nepal) (after climbing Mt. Churen successfully.

Excludes

- International flight airfare (from and to Kathmandu).
- Nepali Visa fee is US\$ 40 per person for 30 days (to be applied for 60 days (USD\$ 90).
- Lunch and dinner during the stay in Kathmandu (also in case of early return from Trekking / Expedition than the scheduled itinerary).
- Extra night's accommodation in Kathmandu in case of early arrival or late departure, early return from Trekking / Expedition (due to any reason) than the scheduled itinerary.
- Travel and high-altitude insurance, accident, medical, and emergency evacuation.
