

Dhaulagiri Expedition 8167m

Standard Itinerary

Dhaulagiri Expedition Itinerary:

Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival in Kathmandu 1350m/4428ft. Airport pickup by a representative of Himalayan Nepal Trek and transfer to hotel on BB plan.

Day 02: Preparation

Preparation, Briefings at Departments of Tourism. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 03: Pokhara

Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara 950m/3,116ft 6 hours. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 04: Darbang

Drive from Pokhara to Darbang 1110m/3,641ft 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 05: Phaliya Gaon

Trek from Darbang to Phaliya Gaon 1850m/6,070ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 06: Muri

Trek from Phaliya Gaon to Muri. 1850m/6,068ft 3/4 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 07: Boghara

Trek from Muri to Boghara 2080m/6,823ft 4/5 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 08: Dobhan Kharka

Treks from Bagar to Dobhan Kharka 2520m 8,266ft 5/6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 09: Sallaghari

Trek from Doban Kharka to Sallaghari 3100m/10,170ft. 5/6 hours. Overnight at a tented camp.

Day 10: Italian Base Camp

Trek from Sallaghari to Italian Base Camp 3660m/12,005ft. 5/6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 11: 5/6 hours.

Rest and acclimatization day at Italian Base Camp before passing. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 12: Dhaulagiri Base Camp

Trek from Italian base camp to Dhaulagiri Base Camp 4750m /15,584ft 5/6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 13-40:

Climbing Period Mt. Dhaulagiri 8167m/26,795ft Base Camp to Base Camp.

Day 41: Base Camp

Preparation to return and clean up the base camp. Overnight at the tented camp.

Day 42: Yak Kharka

Trek from Dhaulagiri base camp to Yak Kharka 4930m/16174ft 6 hours. Overnight at a tented camp.

Day 43: Tukuche

Trek from Yak Kharka to Tukuche 2590m/8,496ft Drive to Tatopani (Hot Spring) 1190m/3,904ft 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 44: Kathmandu

Drive from Tatopani to Kathmandu via Beni/ Pokhara 1350m/4,429ft 10 hours. Transportation is provided by tourist minibus. Overnight at the hotel on the BB plan.

Day 45: Kathmandu

Leisure day, evening farewell dinner in a typical Nepali cultural restaurant. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 46: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination our representative will assist you to the airport for your further destination ahead.

Includes and Excludes

Includes

- 2 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 4 nights hotel in Kathmandu 5* Marriott Hotel single room on bed and breakfast plan.
- 1 Welcome Dinner in a Nepali cultural dance restaurant with office Staff.
- Assistance for cargo clearance in Nepal's Customs, clearance cost is subject to a charge.
- 1 night Hotel in Pokhara (3-star category) twin Sharing room on Bed and breakfast plan.
- Expedition Royalty and permit of Nepal Government to climb Mt. Dhaulagiri, Annapurna Conservation area entry permits and fee.
- 1 Government Liaison officer with full equipment, salary, and accommodation.
- Stool Shipment Transfer & Garbage Deposit fees.
- Medical & Emergency rescue Insurance for all involved Nepalese staff during the trek and expedition.
- Trekking and climbing map.
- One Himalayan Nepal Trek Duffle Bag.
- Drive by tourist Bus from Kathmandu to Pokhara and drive from Pokhara to Darbang (by jeep) While returning; Drive from Tukucho to Tatopani (by jeep) from Tatopani to Kathmandu Jeep Tourist Bus as per itinerary
- Transportation of all necessary equipment for all Members and Staff from Kathmandu to Darbang (by Bus) and from Darbang to Base camp (By Porters or Mules– depending upon condition) While returning; Base camp to Tukucho Mules or Porters– depending upon condition) and Tukucho to Kathmandu (by Bus).
- Up to 60 Kg per member for personal baggage during the trek carrying by porters or mules.
- 3 meals a day (breakfast, lunch, and dinner; including tea and coffee) along with accessible accommodation at Hotel/Lodge during the trek and at the Base Camp, Hygienic and fresh green vegetables, fresh meat, fruits, soft drinks, and juice will be served regularly during the entire expedition using Porters close by Marpha Well-managed base camp set up for members and Staffs.

- All necessary logistic arrangements for camping during the trek.
- 1 Porter per member up to and from Base camp (both ways).
- Experienced and well-trained Base Camp Cook and kitchen Helpers as required.
- All Nepalese staff and porter's daily wages, salary, equipment, food, and clothing.
- Each member will have an individual north-face tent in Base Camp.
- Single Tent, foam mattresses and pillow per member, 1 Dining Tent, 1 Kitchen Tent, 1 Communication tent, 1 Toilet and 1 Shower Tent, 1 Staffs Tent, 1 Tent for Nepalese base camp staff, Store tents, Tables, chairs, and all necessary cooking gears.
- Heater at base camp in each Dining.
- 1 Solar panel and Generator for lights at base camp, for the battery charges, laptop, and other electronic devices.
- Oxygen, Mask Regulator, Ice wall, and Ladder training at base Camp by a professional guide.
- 1 veteran and government-licensed climbing Sherpa per member (1 Member: 1 Sherpa) during the entire climb from Base Camp to the summit and back, and on each rotation.
- Climbing Sherpa to assist in carrying your gear to the high camps.
- Climbing Sherpa's Salary, Equipment, Food, and Clothing.
- Summit Oxygen: 3 oxygen bottles (4 liters) for each member and 1 oxygen bottle for each high-altitude Sherpa.
- 1 Set of Summit Oxygen masks and regulator for each member and high-altitude Sherpa, which has to be returned after the expedition.
- Back up Oxygen Cylinder, mask, and regulator (with appropriate charge).
- High Altitude Tent, Necessary cooking EPI gas, cooking pot, High food for a member, Sherpa, and other crews at (C1), (C2), and (C3) Group climbing gears and fixed and dynamic rope during the climbing period as required. Members will share tents in the above-high camps (2 members: 1 tent).
- The team of experienced Sherpas (including personal Sherpa) will fix the route in Dhaulagiri (no extra charge will be applied to members).
- A Satellite Phone for emergency communication carried by Sherpa is also available for members at an appropriate charge.
- Walkie-Talkie for communicating from Base Camp to Mountain and Mountain to Base Camp.
- Satellite Phone/Walkie-talkie permit for all members and staff.
- Internet facility will be available at the Base Camp (subject to a charge).
- Weather forecast reports regularly from Meteotest, Bern (Switzerland) during the entire expedition.

- Comprehensive Medical kit for members and staff.
- Mt. Dhaulagiri climbing certificate issued by the Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Civil Aviation (Nepal) (after climbing Mt. Dhaulagiri successfully).

Excludes

- International flight airfare (from and to Kathmandu).
 - Nepalese Visa fee is USD 125 for 90 Days.
 - Lunch & dinner during the stay in Kathmandu and Pokhara (also in case of early return from Trekking / Expedition than the scheduled itinerary).
 - Extra nights' accommodation in Kathmandu and Pokhara, In case of early arrival or late departure, early return from Trekking / Expedition, domestic flight (due to any other reason) than the scheduled itinerary.
 - Insurance covering both medical and high-altitude evacuation costs (for the trip cancellation, interruption, high-altitude rescue & air evacuation, medical treatment, repatriation, etc.) is Mandatory.
 - Telephone Calls, Internet, Toiletries, battery recharge, hot shower, laundry, soft drinks, beers, and any Alcoholic beverages (during the trek and in Kathmandu but we will have soft drinks for members at base camp).
 - Clothing, Packing Items, Bags, Personal Medical kits, and all kinds of Personal Trekking / Climbing Gear.
 - Soaps, shampoos, toilet and tissue papers, toothpaste, and other items used to keep yourself clean.
 - Special Filming, Camera, and Drone permit fee.
 - Internet service during the trek.
 - Summit bonus for climbing Sherpa- Minimum 1500 USD.
 - Calculate some tips for Basecamp staff – Minimum 400 USD.
 - Any other services or activities, which are not mentioned in the itinerary and other items not listed in the "Cost Includes" section.
