Dhorpatan Trek Itinerary:

Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrive at Kathmandu airport at 1310m

As you land at Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu, you will be received by the representative staff from Himalayan Nepal Trek with a proper greeting. Then, afterward, you will be transferred to the hotel where you will learn the detailed itinerary. We can change the set itinerary as per your feasibility. Stay overnight in a hotel.

Day 02: Beni

Drive from Kathmandu to Beni 899 m/ 2,949 ft 8/9 hours.

On the following day, you will take breakfast and then head to Beni, a beautiful destination after you depart from Kathmandu. Taking an extensive drive from 9 to 10 hours is the beginning of the trek. You might be very excited to begin the trek and engage yourself in such a long drive you might be tired although you are enjoying the drive. Stay overnight in a lodge.

Day 03: Dharapani

Drive from Beni to Dharapani 1,859 m/6,102 feet 5 hours.

On the 3rd day, you will leave Beni and then go for another drive to Darbang. Today you don't need to go for a long drive like yesterday so you will enjoy the drive of 2 to 3 hours. Arriving in Darbang you will begin the trek toward Dharapni and which takes 5 hours. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 04: Lamsung

Trek to Lamsung 2,160 m/ 7,086 ft 6 hours.

On the next day, you will set out from Dharani to Lamsung which is found at an elevation of 2250m, and it takes 6 hours of time frame to complete the trek. Here, at Lamsung nature will illustrate you with dramatic and intense views. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 05: Jaljala

Trek to Jaljala 3,430 m/ 11,253 ft 7 hours.

On the following day, you will move towards Jaljala which is set to be the attitude of 3430m taking 7 hours. Jaljala is known as not so developed part of Nepal in terms of modern infrastructure. But it is one of the targeted destinations of trekkers, so it is known as the Hidden Treasure as well from where view the entire range of high mountains. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 06: Dhorpatan

Trek to Dhorpatan 2,860 m/ 9,383 ft 7 hours.

Trekking in Dhorpatan will be carried out the next day after you depart from Jaljala. Dhorpatan is acknowledged for its stunning deserted countryside. Its characteristic is the Wildlife Reserve with stunning, uneven areas, and is a paradise for hunters to hunt Blue Sheep. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 07: Dhorpatan

Exploration and trek to Phagune Phedi 3,850 m/ 12,631 ft 4 hours.

Exploring and enjoying hunting in Dhorpatan today you will again go for exploration near to it where you will spot major endangered animals. Then you will trek to Phagune Phedi which is to be found at an elevation of 4493m and it consumes 3 to 4 hours. The trail will make you climb sharply and let you enjoy the attractive vistas of dense jungles, mountains, and landscapes. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 08: Jungle Camp

Hike to Phagune Danda and trek back to Jungle Camp 7 hours.

On the following day, you will leave Phangune Phedi to hike Phangune Danda. From there you will trek back to Jungle Camp which consumes 7 hours. Stay overnight in a tented camp. Overall, you will admire and enjoy the trek to its fullest. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 09: Gurjaghat

Trek to Gurjaghat 3,104 m/ 10,183 ft 6 hours.

Trekking in Gurjaghat is very enthralling so on this day you will stroll from Jungle Camp towards it where you can see beautiful Rhododendron and some wildlife. Walking for 6 hours is like traveling on the journey of bliss on flat land with the merge of jungle and streams. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 10: Patichaur

Trek to Patichaur 2,097 m/6,883 ft 6 hours.

On the following day taking ascending from Gurjaghat in the initial phase will make you take downward moves. The trekking trail will make you stroll into the jungles and gorges. The journey from Gurjaghat to Patichaur takes 6 hours. Stay overnight in a tented camp.

Day 11: Darbang

Trek to Darbang 5 hrs and drive to Beni 899 m/ 2,949 ft 8 hours.

On the next day, you will move from Patichaur to Darbang which takes 5 hours. Initially, you will take upward movement and then once you turn up to Darbang you will take a drive to Beni taking 2 to 3 hours. All through the light jungle and gorges, you will set your mark. Stay overnight in a lodge.

Day 12: Pokhara

On the following day, you will drive from Beni to Pokhara Valley where the beautiful display of nature will already take your heart. Driving for some time you will take a peek and have your lunch. Continuing the drive, you will get to see the rivers, people working in their fields, and high mountains and hills. We have booked the hotel near Lakeside so that you can view the scene from the hotel. Stay overnight in a hotel.

Day 13: Kathmandu

Drive to Kathmandu 200km 6/7 hours.

Spending a beautiful time in Pokhara you will go for a drive to Kathmandu taking 6 hours. This will be a joyous adventurous journey. Arriving in Kathmandu you will be transferred to the hotel evening farewell dinner with a typical Nepali culture dance restaurant and stay at star label hotel on BB plan.

Day 14: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination our representative will assist you to the airport for your further destination.

Includes and Excludes

Includes

- 2 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 3 Times food per day during the trek. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner including tea or coffee.
- 2 Night 3* star label hotel in Kathmandu on BB plan (on twin sharing basis).
- Dive by public van Kathmandu to Beni 295.4 km guest and guide (optional way flight to Pokhra and private vehicle if guest required).
- Drive from Beni to Dharapani by public jeep guest and guide.
- Dive by public jeep from Dharapani to Beni guest and guide.
- Dive by public jeep from Beni to Pokhara guest and guide.
- Drive to Kathmandu 200 km by tourist bus guest and guide (optional way flight to Kathmandu and private vehicle if guest required).
- Staff transportation Kathmandu/Dharapani/Kathmandu.
- Twin-sharing accommodation during the trek (Tent/guest house/Tea house and lodge).
- Experienced English-speaking local guide (Trained and licensed holder by the government of Nepal) and other languages as per the guest's requirements.
- Necessary Porter: Porter carries 25kg.
- Fully camping service north face tent for guests, dining tent, kitchen tent, toilet tent, mattress, kitchen equipment, camping crew, etc.
- All Government and Local Taxes.
- Annapurna conservation area project entry permits (ACAP).
- National Park entry permit.
- Trekking information management systems (TIMS card).
- First aid and equipment for a porter for the extreme adventure route.
- Guide and porter salary as per the company policy and government rules.

- Trip cancellation cost, loss, damage, and personal effects.
- Entrance fees for temples, monasteries, and museums during sightseeing and trekking.

- Additional overnight stays cost at any place (due to any reason) except for mentioned itinerary.
