## Standard Itinerary

### Dromo Peak Climbing Itinerary:

#### Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival at Kathmandu International Airport, welcome Program by Himalayan Nepal Trek staff transfer to Hotel in Kathmandu on BB Plan.

#### Day 02: Kathmandu

Sightseeing in Kathmandu valley Patan, Pashupatinath, Boudhanath, Swayambhunath. Overnight at hotel.

#### Day 03: Biratnagar

Flight from Kathmandu to Biratnagar 94m. Overnight hotel on BB Plan.

#### Day 04: Taplejung

Drive to Taplejung 2420m by Local Bus 8/9 hours stay at Lodge.

#### Day 05: Sekathum

Drive by public jeep to Sekathum 1650m 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 06: Amjilasa

Trek to Amjilasa 2490m 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 07: Gyabla

Trek to Gyabla 2725m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 08: Ghunsa

Trek to Ghunsa 3415m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 09: Ghunsa

Rest day for acclimatization visit monastery around Ghunsa stays at Lodge.

## **Day 10: Khambachen**

Trek to Khambachen 4145m 4/5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 11: Lhonak**

Trek to Lhonak 4792m 3 ½ hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 12: Kanchenjunga Base Camp**

Trek to Kanchenjunga Base camp (KBC) 5140m. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 13: Lhonak**

Early morning climbing to Dromo Peak 6200m see the incredible views of Mount Kanchenjunga, Nepal Peak, Dromo peak, Kirat Chuli, Kangbachen, and many more. return to Kanchenjunga Base camp Lunchtrek to Lhonak 4792m, 9/10 hours stay at Lodge.

## **Day 14: Ghunsa**

Trek to Ghunsa 3415m 5/6 hours. Overnight at the Lodge.

## **Day 15: Gyabla**

Trek to Gyabla 2725m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 16: Sekathum**

Trek to 1650m for 4 hours and drive to Taplejung for 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 17: Bhadrapur**

Drive by public jeep to Bhadrapur airport for 7/8 hours. Overnight at the hotel.

## **Day 18: Kathmandu**

Flight back to Kathmandu transfer to hotel evening farewell dinner in a typical Nepali culture restaurant. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

## **Includes and Excludes**

### **Includes**

- 4 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- Permit preparation and sightseeing in Kathmandu, Pashupatinath, Patan, Swayambhunath, Boudhanath, etc stay overnight at star label hotel on BB plan.
- 3 Times food per day during the trek. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner including tea or coffee.
- 3 Night 3\* star label hotel in Kathmandu on BB plan (on twin sharing basis).
- Domestic flight from Kathmandu to Bhadrapur airport guest and guide (optional: private vehicle or public bus to Taplejung as per participant's preference).
- Drive from Bhadrapur by public jeep to Taplejung/Sekathum/ Bhadrapur (optional: private vehicle as per participant's preference).
- Staff transportation Kathmandu/Sekathum /Kathmandu.
- Twin-sharing accommodation during the trek (Tea house, Lodge Hotel).
- Experienced English-speaking trekking and climbing guide (Trained and licensed holder by the government of Nepal).
- Assistance climbing Sherpa 5:1 during the climbing period.
- North Face tent for guests, dining tent, kitchen tent, toilet tent, and mattress.
- Climbing equipment's ice screw, rope, ice axe, screw gate, karabiners (2 locks, 2 unlock), and snow bar.
- Necessary Porter: Porter carries 25kg.
- All Government and Local Taxes.
- Dromo Peak Climbing Permit Nepal Tourism Board (NTB).
- Conservation Area entry permits (KCAP).
- Restricted area permits.
- Trekking Information Management System (TIMS card).
- First aid and equipment for a porter for the extreme adventure route.
- Guide and porter salary as per the company policy and government rules.
- Duffel bag during the trek.
- Company t-shirt.

- Route map.
- Staffs medical insurance during the trek.

## **Excludes**

- Participants' trekking equipment.
  - Personal expenses such as alcoholic beverages, phone, battery charging, hot shower, hot/mineral water, and laundry.
  - Emergency rescue and travel Insurance (most required factor in high altitude trek).
  - Trip cancellation cost, loss, damage, and personal effects.
  - Entrance fees for temples, monasteries, and museums during sightseeing and trekking.
  - Tips and gratuities for the staff.
