#### **Kumbakarna Himal Expedition Itinerary:**

# Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival at Kathmandu International Airport, welcome by Himalayan Nepal Trek staff transfer to Hotel in Kathmandu on BB Plan.

# **Day 02: Preparation**

Preparation, Briefings at Departments of Tourism. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

# Day 03: Bhadrapur

Flight from Kathmandu to Bhadrapur 94m. 45 minutes Overnight at hotel on BB Plan.

# Day 04: Ranipul

Drive by jeep to Helok Khola or Ranipul 1792m 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

# Day 05: Sherpa Gaun

Trek from Ranipul to Sherpa Gaun 1,740 m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

### Day 06: Torongten

Trek from Sherpa Gaun to Torongten via Lashetham 3,646 m 9/10 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

### Day 07: Tseram

Trek from Torongten to Tseram 3,868m 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

### Day 08: Tseram

Rest acclimatization day hike to above 4000m back to Tseram. Overnight at Lodge.

# Day 09: Ramche

Trek from Tseram to Ramche 4,610 m 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

# Day 10: Kumbakarna Base Camp

Trek from Ramche to Kumbakarna Base Camp (Janu Himal) 6/7 hours. Overnight at Tent.

# Day 11- 27:

Climbing period Kumbakarna 7,710 m (25,300 ft) Base Camp Summit Base Camp.

# Day 28: Ramche

Trek from Base Camp to Ramche for 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

### Day 29: Torongten

Trek from Ramche to Torongten 2,980 m 6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

# Day 30: Ranipul

Trek via Lashetham 3,646 m and Helok Khola or Ranipul 1792m 8/9 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

# Day 31: Ilam tea garden

Drive by public jeep to Ilam Tea Garden 370m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

# Day 32: Kathmandu

Drive to Bhadrapur airport fly back to Kathmandu transfer to the hotel evening farewell dinner with a Typical Nepali Culture restaurant. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

# Day 33: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination our representative will assist you to the airport for your further destination ahead.

#### Includes and Excludes

#### **Includes**

- 4 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 3 nights hotel in Kathmandu 5\* Marriott Hotel twin sharing room on bed and breakfast plan.

- 1 Night Hotel in Bhadrapur twin sharing room on bed and breakfast plan.
- 1 Farewell Diner in Nepali cultural dance restaurant.
- Assistance for cargo clearance in Nepal's Customs, clearance cost is subject to a charge.
- Expedition Royalty and a permit fee from Nepal Government to climb Mt. Kumbakarna Kanchanjunga Conservation Area entry permit fee.
- Restricted area permit.
- 1 Government Liaison officer with full equipment, salary, food, and accommodation.
- Stool Shipment Transfer and Garbage Deposit fees.
- Medical and Emergency rescue Insurance for all involved Nepalese staff during the trek and expedition.
- Trekking and climbing map.
- One Himalayan Nepal Trek Duffel Bag.
- Domestic Flight: Fly from Kathmandu / Bhadrapur and while returning Bhadrapur / Kathmandu, as per itinerary.
- Bhadrapur /Helok Khola Ranipu/Bhadrapur by jeep member and personal luggage.
- All necessary expedition equipment transportation for all Members and Staff from Kathmandu to Helok Khola Ranipul/Kathmandu by land transport and Base camp by Porters / Yak) While returning: Base Camp to Helok Khola Ranipul by porters / Yak) and Helok Khola Ranipul to Kathmandu by land transport.
- Up to 60 Kg per member for personal baggage during the trek to be carried by porters or Yaks.
- 3 meals a day (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) including tea and coffee along with accessible accommodation at Hotel/Lodge during the trek and at the base camp. Hygienic and fresh green vegetables, fresh meat, fruits, and soft drinks will be served during the entire expedition.
- Porters per member up to the Base camp and from the Base Camp both ways from Helok Khola Ranipul to Helok Khola Ranipul.
- Experienced and well-trained Base Camp Cook and kitchen Helpers.
- All Nepalese staff & porters' daily wages, salary, equipment, food & clothing.
- Each member will have an individual north-face tent in Base Camp.
- Single Tent, foam mattresses and pillow per member, 1 Dinning Tent, 1 Kitchen Tent, 1 Toilet
  & 1 Shower Tent, 1 Staffs Tent, 1 Tent for Nepalese base camp staff, Store tents, Tables & chairs & all necessary cooking gear.
- Solar panel for lights at base camp, battery charge, laptop, and other electronic devices.
- Oxygen, Mask Regulator, Ice wall, and gear training at base camp by Sherpa Guide.

- 1 veteran and government-licensed climbing Sherpa per member (1 Member: 1 Sherpa), during the entire climb from Base Camp to the summit and back, and on each rotation.
- Climbing Sherpa to assist in carrying your gear to the high camps.
- Climbing Sherpa's Salary, Equipment, Food, and Clothing.
- Carry Bonus of Sherpa's and Route Fixing Charges.
- Oxygen bottles will be in stock at base camp in case of an emergency (with an appropriate charge).
- 1 Set of Summit Oxygen masks will be in base camp in case of an emergency.
- High Altitude Tent, Necessary cooking EPI gas, cooking pot, High food for a member, Sherpa, and other crews at (C1) (C2), and (C3). Group climbing gears, and fixed and dynamic rope during the climbing period as required.
- Members will share tents in the above-high camps (2 members: 1 tent).
- The team of experienced Sherpas will fix the rope and the route.
- Satellite Phone for emergency communication carried by Sherpa, also available for members with an appropriate charge.
- Walkie-Talkie for communicating from Base Camp to Mountain and Mountain to Base Camp.
- Walkie-talkie permit for all members and staff.
- Comprehensive Medical kit for members and staff.
- Climbing certificate issued by Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Civil Aviation (Nepal) after climbing Mt, Kumbakarna successfully.

#### **Excludes**

- International flight airfare (from and to Kathmandu).
- Nepali Visa fee is 60 USD per person for 30 days (to be applied for 60 days is USD 120.
- Lunch and dinner during the stay in Kathmandu (also in case of early return from Trekking / Expedition than the scheduled itinerary).
- Extra nights' accommodation in Kathmandu, In case of early arrival or late departure, early return from Trekking / Expedition, or domestic flight cancellation (due to any other reason) than the scheduled itinerary.
- Insurance covering both medical and high-altitude evacuation costs (for the trip cancellation, interruption, high-altitude rescue and air evacuation, medical treatment, repatriation, etc.)
   Mandatory.
- Telephone Calls, Internet, Toiletries, battery recharge, hot shower, laundry, soft drinks, beers, and any Alcoholic beverages (during the trek and in Kathmandu but we will have soft drinks for members at base camp).

- Clothing, Packing Items, Bags, Personal Medical kits, and all kinds of Personal Trekking / Climbing Gear.
- Soaps, shampoos, toilet and tissue papers, toothpaste, and other items used to keep yourself clean.
- Special Filming, Camera, and Drone permit fee.
