

# Larke Peak Climbing

## Standard Itinerary

### Larke Peak Climbing Itinerary:

#### Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival at Kathmandu 1310m, Welcome program by Himalayan Nepal Trek and direct transfer to hotel on BB plan.

#### Day 02: Kathmandu

Preparation, Briefings Manaslu restricted permit issues with your original passport shopping in Kathmandu Overnight at the hotel on BB plan.

#### Day 03: Machhakhola

Drive from Kathmandu to Machhakhola 1330m/3051ft 10 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 04: Jagat

Trek from Machhakhola to Jagat 1350m/4429ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 05: Dang

Trek from Jagat to Dang 2310m/7579ft 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 06: Namrung

Trek from Dang to Namrung 2618m/8589ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 07: Shayala

Trek from Namrung to Shayala 3500m/11482 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 08: Samagaun

Trek from Shalya to Samagaun 3520m via Pungen monastery 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

#### Day 09: Samagaun

Acclimatization and exploration day for rest at Samagaun 3500m hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 10: Samdo**

Trek from Samagaun to Samdo 3850m 4 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 11: Dharmsala**

Trek from Samdo to Dharmsala 4460m/14,633ft 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 12: Larke Base Camp**

Trek from Dharmsala to Larke Base Camp 5480m 6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

## **Day 14: Larke Base Camp**

Reserve day

## **Day 15: Larke Base Camp**

Early morning climb to Larke Peak, Summit 6249m, and back to Base Camp 5480m 8 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

## **Day 16: Bhimthang**

Trek from Larke Base Camp via Larkya La, 5215m to Bhimthang 3590m 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 17: Dharapani**

Trek from Bhimthang to Dharapani, 1920m 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

## **Day 18: Kathmandu**

Drive from Dharapani to Kathmandu via Beshisahar, and transfer to the hotel. Evening farewell dinner in a typical Nepali cultural restaurant with a dance program. Overnight at hotel on BB plan.

## **Day 19: Departure**

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination. Our representative will drop you at the airport.

## Includes and Excludes

### Includes

- 2 Times airport pick up and drops (international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 3 Times food per day during the trek. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner including tea or coffee.
- 3 Night 3\* star label hotel in Kathmandu on BB plan (on twin sharing basis).
- Drive from Kathmandu to Soti Khola by local bus 8/9 overnight at Lodge guest and guide (optional: private vehicle as per participant's preference).
- Drive from Dharapani to Kathmandu by public bus guest and guide (optional: private vehicle as per participant's preference).
- Staff transportation Kathmandu/ Soti Khola /Dharapani/Kathmandu.
- Twin-sharing accommodation during the trek (guest house/tea house and lodge, tented camp).
- Experienced English-speaking trekking and climbing guide (Trained and licensed holder by the government of Nepal).
- Assistance climbing Sherpa 5:1 during the climbing period.
- North Face tent for guests, dining tent, kitchen tent, toilet tent, and mattress.
- Climbing equipment's ice screw, rope, ice axe, screw gate, karabiners (2 locks, 2 unlock), and snow bar.
- Necessary Porter 2:1 (one porter for two guests) porter carries 25kg.
- All Government local Taxes.
- Peak climbing permit from Nepal Mountaineering Association (NMA).
- Conservation Area entry permits (MCAP).
- Annapurna Conservation Area entry permits (ACAP).
- Manaslu area restricted area permits.
- Trekking Information Management System (TIMS card).
- First aid and equipment for a porter for the extreme adventure route.
- Guide and porter salary as per the company policy and government rules.
- Facilities to store your stuff at a hotel in Kathmandu.
- Duffel bag during the trek, company t-shirt, route map.
- Staffs medical rescue insurance during the trip.

### Excludes

- Participant's trekking equipment and any type of personal expenses such as alcoholic beverages, phone, battery charging, hot shower, hot/mineral water, and laundry.
  - Extra porters if guests are required.
  - Emergency rescue and travel Insurance (most required factor in high altitude trek)
  - Trip cancellation cost, loss, damage, and personal effects.
  - Entrance fees for temples, monasteries, and museums during sightseeing and trekking.
  - Tips and gratuities for the staff.
  - Additional overnight stays cost at any place (due to any reason) except for mentioned itinerary.
