Standard Itinerary

Makalu Expedition Itinerary:

Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival in Kathmandu 1350m/4428ft. Airport pickup by a representative of Himalayan Nepal Trek and transfer to hotel on BB plan.

Day 02: Preparation

Preparation, Briefings at Departments of Tourism, Last minute shopping overnight at Hotel on BB.

Day 03: Num

Fly from Kathmandu to Tumlingtar 50-minute drive by jeep to Num 1980m/6,496ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 04: Seduwa

Trek from Num to Seduwa 1500m/4,922ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 05: Tashigaoun

Trek from Seduwa to Tashigaoun 2100m/6,890ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 06: Khongma Danda

Trek from Tashigaoun to Khongma Danda 3500m/11483ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 07: Khongma

Exploration and acclimatization day at Khongma 3500m/11,483ft Overnight at Lodge.

Day 08: Dobato

Trek from Khongma to Dobato 3650m/11,975ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 09: Yangle Kharka

Trek from Dobute to Yangle Kharka 3600m/11,811ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 10: Langmale Kharka

Trek from Yangle Kharka to Langmale Kharka 4410m/14469ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 11: Langmale Kharka

Exploration and acclimatization day at Langmale Kharka 4410m/14,469ft. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 12: Makalu Base Camp

Trek from Langmale Kharka to Makalu Base Camp 5018m/16,464ft 6 hours. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 13: Makalu Base Camp

Rest and acclimatization at Makalu Base Camp 5018m/16,464ft. Overnight at a tented camp.

Day 14: Advance Base Camp

Trek from Makalu Base Camp, Hillary base camp to Advance Base Camp 5600m/18,373ft 5 hours. Overnight at a tented camp.

Day 15-50:

The climbing period for Makalu (8485m/27,838ft) Base Camp to Base Camp.

Day 51: Yangle Kharka

Trek from Advance Base Camp to Yangle Kharka 3600m/11,811ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 52: Dobato

Trek from Yangli Kharka to Dobato 3650m/11,975ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 53: Khongma

Trek from Dobute to Khongma 3500m/11,483ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 54: Seduwa

Trek from Khongma to Seduwa 1500m/4,922ft) 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 55: Num

Trek from Seduwa to Num 1980m/6,496ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 56: Tumlingtar

Drive by jeep from Num to Tumlingtar for 4 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 57: Kathmandu

Fly from Tumlingtar to Kathmandu (50 min) and transfer to the hotel on the BB plan.

Day 58: Kathmandu

Leisure day, evening farewell dinner in a typical Nepali cultural restaurant. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 59: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination our representative will assist you to the airport for your further destination ahead.

Includes and Excludes

Includes

- 4 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 3 nights hotel in Kathmandu 5* Marriott Hotel single room on bed and breakfast plan
- Welcome Dinner in a Nepali cultural dance restaurant with office Staff.
- Assistance for cargo clearance in Nepal Customs, clearance cost is subject to a charge.
- Expedition Royalty and permit of Nepal Government to climb Mt. Makalu,
- Makalu-Barun National Park entry permit fee.
- 1 Government Liaison officer with full equipment, salary, and accommodation.
- Stool Shipment Transfer and Garbage Deposit fees.
- Medical and Emergency rescue Insurance for all involved Nepalese staff during the trek and expedition.
- Trekking and Climbing Route Map.

- Domestic Flight: Fly from Kathmandu to Tumlingtar and drive a jeep from Tumlingtar to Num. While returning drive from Num to Tumlingtar by jeep and fly from Tumlingtar to Kathmandu, as per the itinerary.
- Necessary all equipment Transportation for all Members and Staff from Kathmandu to Num by bus, jeep, and to Base camp (by Porters) While returning: Base camp to Tumlingtar (by porters and Jeep) and Tumlingtar to Kathmandu (by vehicle) Member's equipment will be transported by air.
- Up to 60 Kg per member for personal baggage during the trek carrying by porter or Yak.
- 3 meals a day Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner including tea and coffee along with accessible accommodation at Hotel/Lodge/Tea house/Camp during the trek and Base Camp Well, managed base camp set up for members and Staff.
- The north face tents will be set up while camping on sharing basis.
- All necessary equipment for camping during the trek.
- Porters per member up to Base camp from Num and Porters return from Base camp to Num.
- Experienced and well-trained Base Camp Cook and kitchen Helpers as required.
- All Nepalese staff and porter's daily wages, equipment, food, and clothing.
- Each member will have an individual North Face tent in Base Camp.
- At Base camp: foam mattresses and pillow per member, 1 Dining Tent, 1 Kitchen Tent, 1 Toilet, 1 Shower Tent, 1 Staffs Tent, 1 Tent for Nepalese base camp staff, Store tents, Tables, chairs, all necessary cooking gear.
- Heater for base camp in each Dining.
- 1 Solar panel or Generator for battery charge and light at base camp for use.
- 1 veteran and Government Licensed Climbing Sherpa per member (1 Member: 1 Sherpa).
- Climbing Sherpa's Salary, Equipment, Food, and Clothing.
- Summit Oxygen cylinder: 3 oxygen bottles (4 liters) for each member and 1 oxygen bottle for each high-altitude Sherpa.
- 1 Set of Summit Oxygen masks & regulators for each member and high-altitude Sherpa.
- Back up Oxygen Cylinder, mask, and regulator (with appropriate charge).
- High Altitude Tent, Necessary cooking EPI gas, cooking pots for a member, High food for a member, Sherpa, all climbing and other crews at (C1), (C2), (C3), and (C4) Group climbing gears, fixed and dynamic rope during the climbing period as required.
- The team of experienced Sherpas will fix the route on Makalu (no extra charge will be applied to members).
- A Satellite Phone for emergency communication carried by Sherpa is also available for members at an appropriate charge.

- Walkie–Talkie for communicating from Base Camp to Mountain and Mountain to Base Camp.
- Satellite Phone/walkie-talkie permit for all members and staff.
- Weather forecast report during the expedition.
- Comprehensive Medical kit for staff and members.
- Mt. Makalu climbing certificate issued by the Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Civil Aviation (Nepal (after climbing Mt. Makalu successfully)).

Excludes

- International flight airfare (from and to Kathmandu).
 - The Nepalese Visa fee is USD 125 for 90 Days.
 - Lunch & dinner during the stay in Kathmandu (also in case of early return from Trekking / Expedition than the scheduled itinerary).
 - Extra nights' accommodation in Kathmandu in case of early arrival or late departure, early return from Trekking / Expedition, or domestic flight cancellation (due to any other reason) than the scheduled itinerary.
 - Insurance covering both medical and high-altitude evacuation costs (for the trip cancellation, interruption, high-altitude rescue and air evacuation, medical treatment, repatriation, etc.)
*Mandatory.
 - Telephone Calls, Internet, Toiletries, battery recharge, hot shower, laundry, soft drinks, beers, and any Alcoholic beverages (during the trek and in Kathmandu but we will have soft drinks for members at base camp).
 - Clothing, Packing Items, Bags, Personal Medical kits, and all kinds of Personal Trekking and Climbing Gear.
 - Soaps, shampoos, toilet and tissue papers, toothpaste, and other items used to keep yourself clean.
 - Special Filming, Camera, and Drone permit fee.
 - Summit bonus for climbing Sherpa minimum 1500 USD.
 - Calculate some tips for Base Camp and high camp staff a minimum of 400 USD per person.
 - Any other services or activities, which are not mentioned in the itinerary and other items not listed in the Cost Includes section.
