Paldor Peak Climbing Itinerary:

Day 01: Kathmandu

Kathmandu airport Arrival at Kathmandu airport 1310m welcome by Himalayan Nepal Trek staff then Transfer to hotel on BB plan.

Day 02: Kathmandu

Permit preparation and sightseeing in Kathmandu Valley. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 03: Shyabrubensi

Drive from Katmandu to Shyabrubensi 1420m by local bus 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 04: Gatlang

Trek from Shyabrubensi to Gatlang for 5/6 hours. Overnight at a Tea house.

Day 04: Yuri Kharka

Trek from Gatlang to Yuri Kharka 3280m 5 hours. Overnight at a Tea house

Day 05: Somdang

Trek from Yuri Kharka to Somdang 3,260m 5 hours via Khurpudanda pass 3,750m 6/7 hours. Overnight at a tented camp.

Day 06: Jasta Khani

Trek from Somdang to Jasta Khani 3700m 6/7 hours. Overnight at a tented camp.

Day 07: Paldor Base Camp

Trek from Jasta Khani to Paldor Base Camp 4280m 6 hours. overnight at a tented camp.

Day 08: Paldor Base Camp

Rest day at Base camp for acclimatization 4280m acclimatization day for the preparation of Paldor peak summit. Overnight tented camp.

Day 09: Paldor High Camp

Trek from Paldor Base Camp to Paldor High Camp. Overnight tented camp.

Day 10: Base camp

Early morning climb to Paldor peak 5896m and back to base camp 7/8 hours. overnight at a tented camp.

Day 11: Somdang

Trek from the Base camp to Somdang 4305m 6/7 hours. Overnight tented camp.

Day 12: Narchet Kharka

Trek from Somdang to Narchet Kharka 3800m 6 hours. Overnight tented camp.

Day 13: Sertung

Trek from Narchet Kharka to Sertung 3270m 6/7 hours. Overnight tented camp.

Day 14: Jharlang

Trek from Sertung to Jharlang 1600m 6 hours. Overnight tented camp.

Day 15: Darkha

Trek from Jharlang to Darkha 1557m 5 hours. Overnight tented camp.

Day 16: Khahare

Trek from Darkhu to Khahare Bazaar 720m. Overnight at Tea house

Day 17: Kathmandu

Trek and drive to Kathmandu and transfer to hotel. Evening farewell dinner in a typical Nepali cultural dance restaurant. Overnight Hotel on BB plan.

Day 18: Departure

Departure from the hotel, our representative will drop you at Kathmandu international airport for your onward destination.

Includes and Excludes

Includes

- 2 Times airport pick up and drops (international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 3 Times food per day during the trek. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner including tea or coffee.
- 3 Night 3* star label hotel in Kathmandu on BB plan (on twin sharing basis).
- Drive from Katmandu to Shyabrubensi 1420 m by local bus 7/8 overnight at Lodge guest and guide (optional: private vehicle as per participant's preference).
- Drive from Khahare Bazaar to Kathmandu by public bus guest and guide (optional: private vehicle as per participant's preference).
- Staff transportation Kathmandu/ Shyabrubensi /Kathmandu.
- Twin-sharing accommodation during the trek (guest house/tea house and lodge, tented camp).
- Experienced English-speaking trekking and climbing guide (Trained and licensed holder by the government of Nepal).
- Assistance climbing Sherpa 5:1 during the climbing period.
- North Face tent for guests, dining tent, kitchen tent, toilet tent, and mattress.
- Climbing equipment's ice screw, rope, ice axe, screw gate, karabiners (2 locks, 2 unlock), and snow bar.
- Necessary Porter 2:1 (one porter for two guests) porter carries 25kg.
- All Government and local Taxes.
- Peak climbing permit from Nepal Mountaineering Association (NMA).
- Langtang National Park entry permits.
- Trekking Information Management System (TIMS card).
- First aid and equipment for a porter for the extreme adventure route.
- Guide and porter salary as per the company policy and government rules.
- Facilities to store your stuff at a hotel in Kathmandu.
- Duffel bag during the trek, company t-shirt, route map.
- Staffs medical rescue insurance during the trip.

Excludes

- Participants trekking equipment and any type of personal expenses such as alcoholic beverages, phone, battery charging, hot shower, hot/mineral water, and laundry.
- Extra porters if guests are required.
- Emergency rescue and travel Insurance (most required factor in high altitude trek).
- Trip cancellation cost, loss, damage, and personal effects.
- Entrance fees for temples, monasteries, and museums during sightseeing and trekking.
- Tips and gratuities for the staff.
- Additional overnight stays cost at any place (due to any reason) except for mentioned itinerary.
